



## **Secrets of the Solent**Intertidal surveys health and safety

There will always be a qualified first aider at our intertidal surveys, and emergency equipment such as throw lines will be provided. Please abide by the following:

- Listen to the survey leader and follow any instructions they give you.
- Take everything you might need onto the beach with you (e.g. shoes, hat, raincoat, sun cream, water).
- Take care when entering and exiting the beach.
- Never enter the water as part of the survey.
- Wear shoes at all times no bare feet.
- Avoiding touching sharp objects.
- Cover any open cuts or other wounds.
- Wash your hands after handling marine objects.
- Let the leader know about any potential hazards you identify.
- Let the leader know about any allergies that might be relevant.
- Let the leader know if you need to leave the group for any reason.
- Let the leader know about any accidents/medical incidents that occur.
- Let your medical professionals know that you have been on a survey if you fall ill afterwards, and let the Trust know if your symptoms are diagnosed as being related to having taken part in the survey.
