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Educational Training for Children 3-5 years

Hampshire & Isle of Wight Wildlife Trust can deliver bespoke tailored training sessions either on setting grounds, at one of our reserves or local coastal areas. Our experienced Education Officers and Forest School leaders are experts at making outdoor learning fun and memorable. Training sessions could be aimed at Early Years staff, volunteers and/or parents and can be tailored to meet the needs of the setting and children.

Examples include:

Wild Beach taster training at the coast or **Forest School taster** training on school grounds or at a reserve.

- Outdoor games and activities to engage children with the natural world.

Our Services

1. Our staff could work alongside your staff and children and explore the wildlife or lead activities on your grounds or local green space.

2. Setting advice and guidance on using your grounds and developing learning outside the classroom.

3. INSET training and professional development courses (CPD) at your setting.


