







Water Voles & Bats Walk

Hampshire Mammal Group invite you on a walk to find out more about the water voles of Winnall Moors with Reserves Officer Rachel Remnant, followed by some bat detecting led by Senior Ecologist Sarah Jackson.

As we walk next to the River Itchen within the reserve, Rachel will explain the surveys happening at Winnall, what we look for and what we have found, we may even be lucky enough to see or hear the characteristic 'plop'!. As it gets dark, we will use bat detectors to identify the bats we encounter as we finish off the walk.

The walk will make use of the main, level paths on Winnall Moors Reserve and be approximately 1km. The ground surface may be uneven so please do wear appropriate footwear and clothing. As it will be getting dark during the walk please do bring a small torch with you.
