Habitats

Compare and contrast 2 or 3 different Swanwick Lakes habitats (woodland, pond and meadow). Construct and act out food chain and webs and investigate how animals are adapted to survive in their habitats.

National Curriculum links: **Sc:** Animals, living things & their habitats, Evolution and inheritance. **Geog:** Physical.

Rocks and Soils

Go on a hands-on, mud-filled adventure to explore different type of rocks and soils and understand how rocks and soils are formed. Have a close up, creative encounter with the naturally occurring Swanwick clay

National Curriculum links: **Sc:** Rocks, including formation, soils and fossils, Working Scientifically **Geog:** Human & physical, geography skills and fieldwork **Hist:** Local history study

Team Survival

Complete team challenges and solve problems; learn to keep still and camouflage yourself and then build a shelter in the woods.

National Curriculum links: **En:** Reading & writing. **D&T:** Designing, making and evaluating, technical knowledge **PSHE.**

Reduce, Reuse and Recycle

Take part in games and hands on activities to find out why it's important for people to reduce, reuse and recycle. Explore the world of compost and learn about recycling in the natural world. Use rubbish to create some wonderful characters to take home with you.
