We will never ask you the size or type of your legacy because every gift makes a difference.

We understand that circumstances can change and there may be a time where you need to take the Wildlife Trust out of your Will.

You may tell us that you would prefer your gift to be directed towards a certain area of work, otherwise we will use it where the need is greatest at that time.

You can tell us that you have left a gift to Hampshire & Isle of Wight Wildlife Trust if you want to, but you do not have to. We will never ask you the size or type of your gift you because whether large or small, every gift makes a difference.

We acknowledge the names of those who leave a gift in their Will in our remembrance book. However, if you would prefer that your gift remains private and anonymous we will of course respect your wishes.

We will never unduly influence legal practitioners to encourage gifts to the Wildlife Trust, nor pressure you to leave a gift in your Will.
